**Why spay your cat before  
having that first litter?**

- \* Do not contribute to the cat  
overpopulation crisis.  
Millions of cats nationwide  
are in shelters awaiting  
homes. Many came in as  
kittens and just did not get  
adopted because supply is  
bigger than demand.**
- \* Letting them give birth may be a complicated outcome.  
It is far less risky to get the female spayed.**

**Why does my cat want to get outside all the time?**

- \* If she is not spayed, she will want to get out when  
she goes in to heat. They are hard wired to want to  
mate. Spaying most likely stops that behavior when  
done before they get used to going outside. They can  
go into heat about 20 times per year.**

**What if my unspayed cat never goes outside?**

- \* They are still at risk for mammary cancer and  
Pyometra- an infected uterus, which is fatal if not  
caught in time.**
