



2019 Volunteer Benefits

After volunteering with FFF for six months volunteers who participate in the following areas are eligible for special benefits for their personal pets.

Volunteers:

- Shelter cleaners
- Volunteers running fundraisers
- Volunteers assisting with surgery sign in, surgery & surgery discharge
- Volunteers assisting with Saturday adoptions
- Foster homes
- Facebook/website administrator
- Redner's tape coordinator
- Newsletter editor
- Aluminum can coordinator

Guidelines for frequency of volunteering to be eligible:

- Shelter Cleaners – Volunteers who clean a minimum of one day every other week
- Fundraisers – Assist with a minimum of one fundraiser per quarter
- Surgery Program – Volunteers who help on a weekly basis
- Saturday Adoptions – Volunteers who help a minimum of two Saturdays a month.

Volunteers will be entitled to reduced prices on the following items:

<i>Distemper vaccination</i>	<i>\$5.00</i>
<i>Spay*</i>	<i>\$50.00</i>
<i>Neuter*</i>	<i>\$25.00</i>
<i>Catego</i>	<i>\$12.00</i>
<i>Profender</i>	<i>\$15.00</i>
<i>Milbemite</i>	<i>\$18.00</i>

*There will be a limit of six surgical procedures a year.

NOTE: Rabies vaccinations must be given by our shelter Vet. If an eligible volunteer brings their pet to a vaccination clinic, they will be entitled to the reduced price of \$5.00.

Leukemia vaccination will not be offered at a discounted price.

The board of directors reserves the right to limit or refuse benefits.
